

Smart Life App – Scene Setup Guide (Tap-to-Run Mode)

This guide shows home users how to create and use Scenes in the Smart Life app. Scenes let you control multiple devices with one tap (Tap-to-Run).

Usage Case Explained

At living room, there are 4 set of lights (Ceiling, Spot, Table Lamp, Floor Lamp). When you watch movie, you wish to have only Table Lamp and Floor Lamp on, while the rest of light in living room are off.

Or

When you leave home, you wish one tap to turn all lights off

Before You Start

- Ensure your devices are already added to Smart Life and appear in your Home list.
- Make sure your phone has internet access (Wi-Fi or mobile data).
- If you plan to use location-based automation, allow location permission for Smart Life.

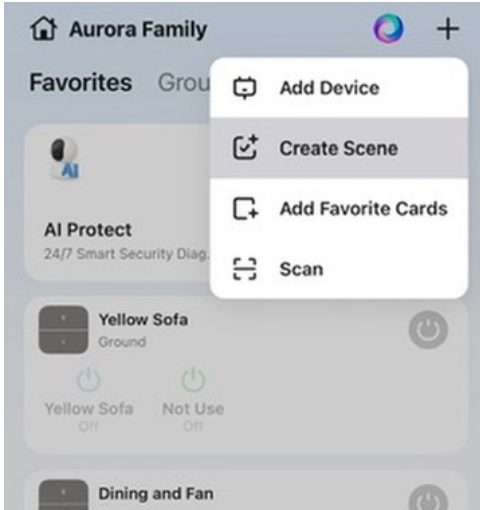
Scene Types (Simple Explanation)

- 1) Tap-to-Run: You press a button in the app to run the scene (best for beginners).
- 2) Automation: The scene runs automatically when a condition is met (time, device status, sensors, etc.).

Step-by-Step: Create a “Tap-to-Run” Mode

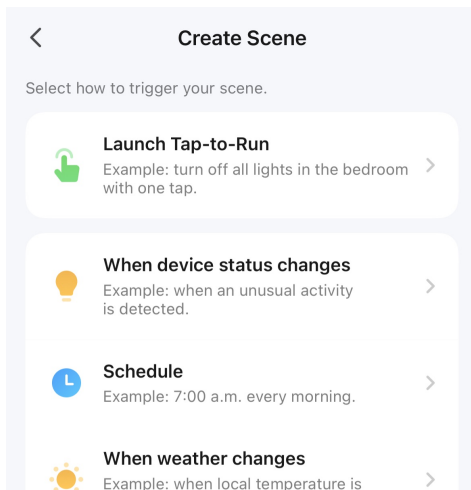
Step 1 – Open the menu

From the Smart Life Home screen, tap '+' then select 'Create Scene'.



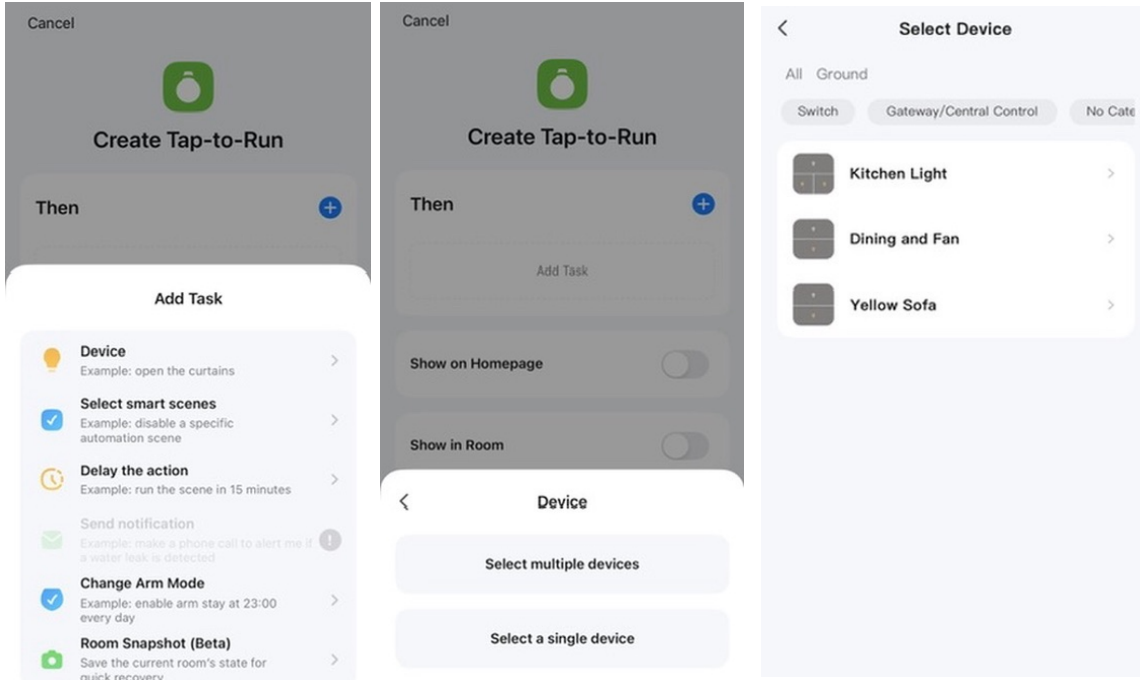
Step 2 – Choose Tap-to-Run

Select 'Tap-to-Run' for a one-tap scene.



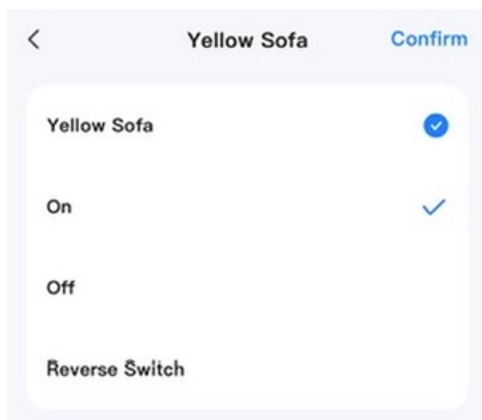
Step 3 – Add Tasks (Select Devices)

Tap 'Add Task' and choose what devices to act (On/ Off) when tap.



Step 4 – Setting Action

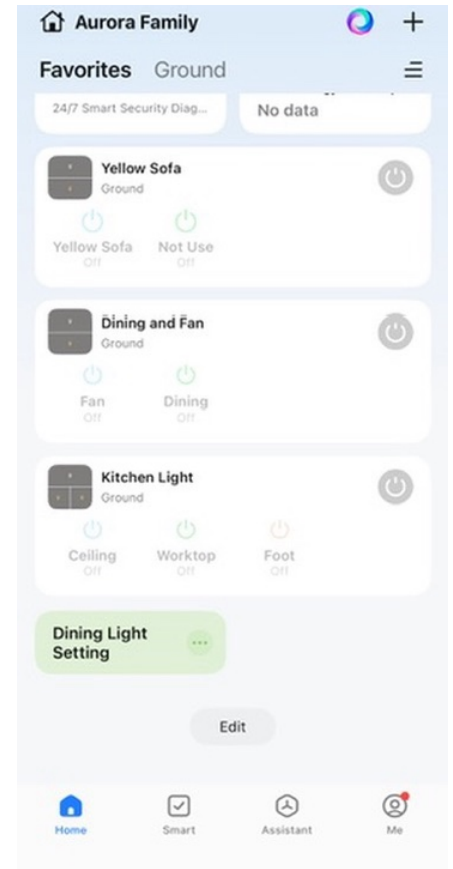
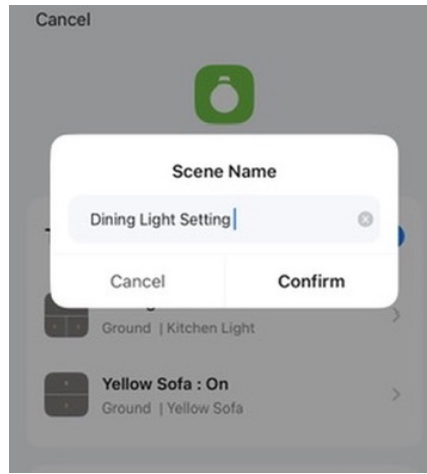
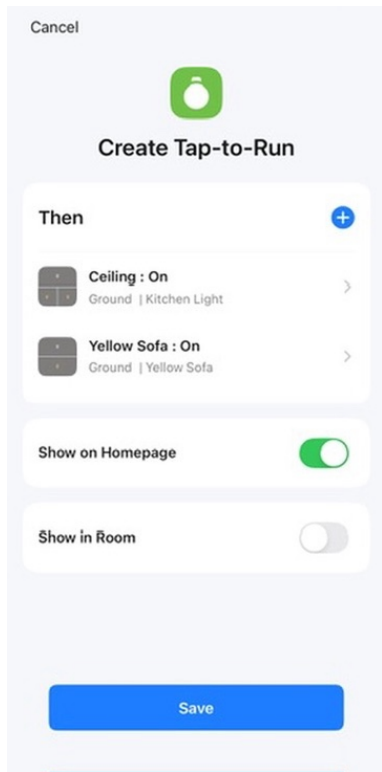
Choose what act (On/ Off / Reverse) when tap for selected device, then confirm. You can repeat Step 3 setting multiple devices to act.



Step 5 – Save the Scene

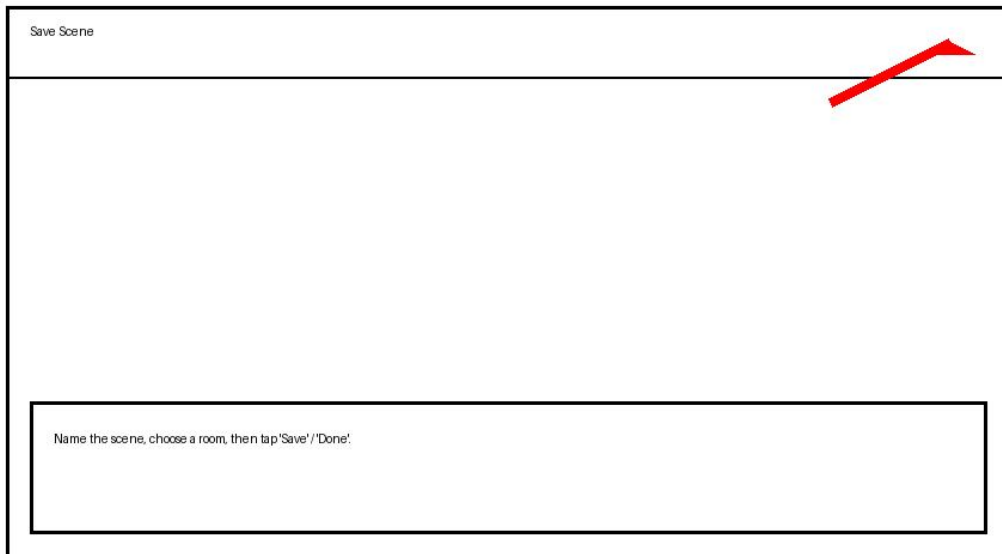
Upon selected devices are selected and associated with the Tap Active “Show in Homepage”

Give the scene a name (for example, 'Movie Night') and confirm. Then at Homepage there is a new “Tap Button” setup.



Step 6 – Test the Scene

Tap the scene to run it and confirm devices respond correctly.



Step 6 – Add to Home (Optional)

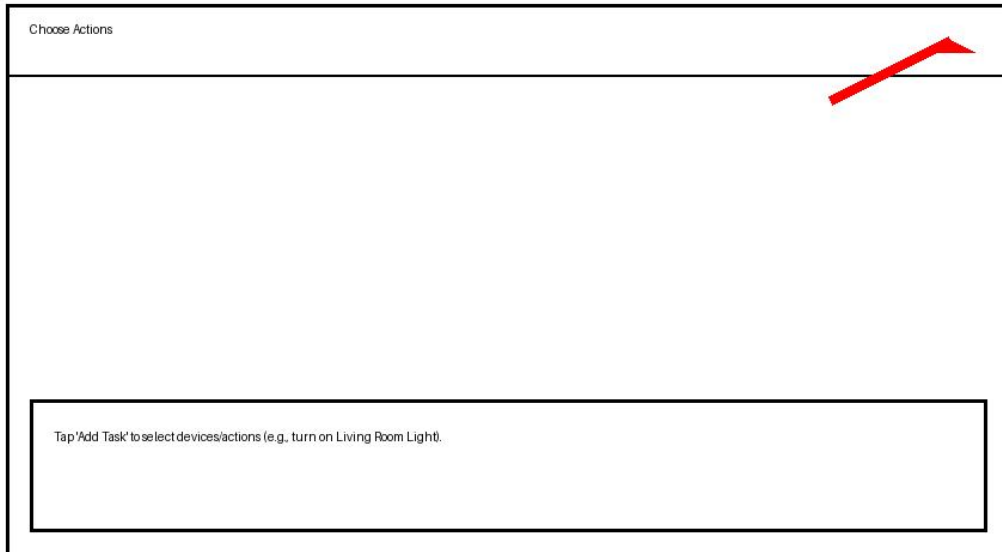
Add the scene to Favorites/Home for faster access.



Step-by-Step: Create an Automation Scene

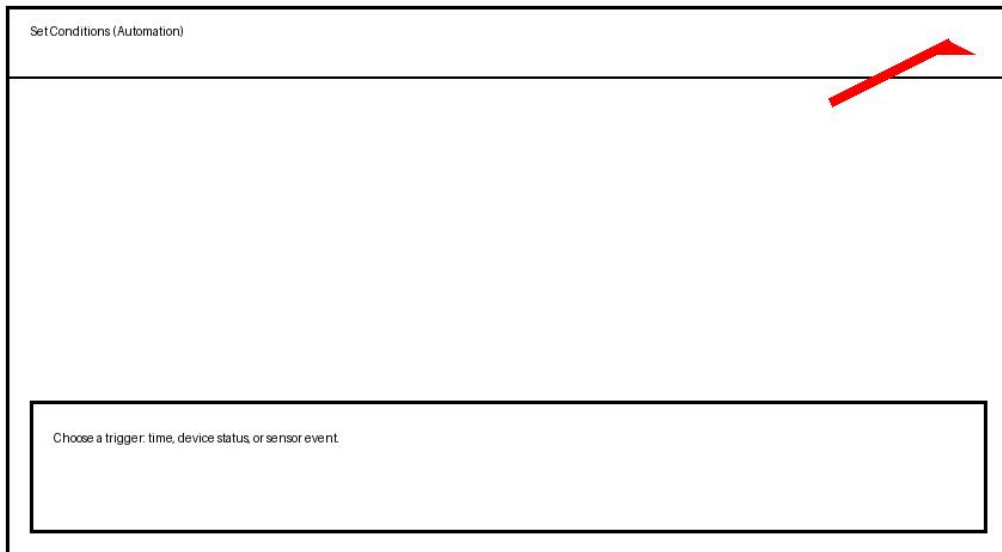
Step 1 – Open the menu

From the Home screen, tap '+' then select 'Create Scene'.




Step 2 – Choose Automation

Select 'Automation' to run actions automatically.



Step 3 – Set When (Trigger)

Choose a trigger, such as schedule/time, device status, or sensor event.



Save Scene

Name the scene, choose a room, then tap 'Save' / 'Done'.

Step 4 – Set Then (Actions)

Tap 'Add Task' and select the devices/actions you want.

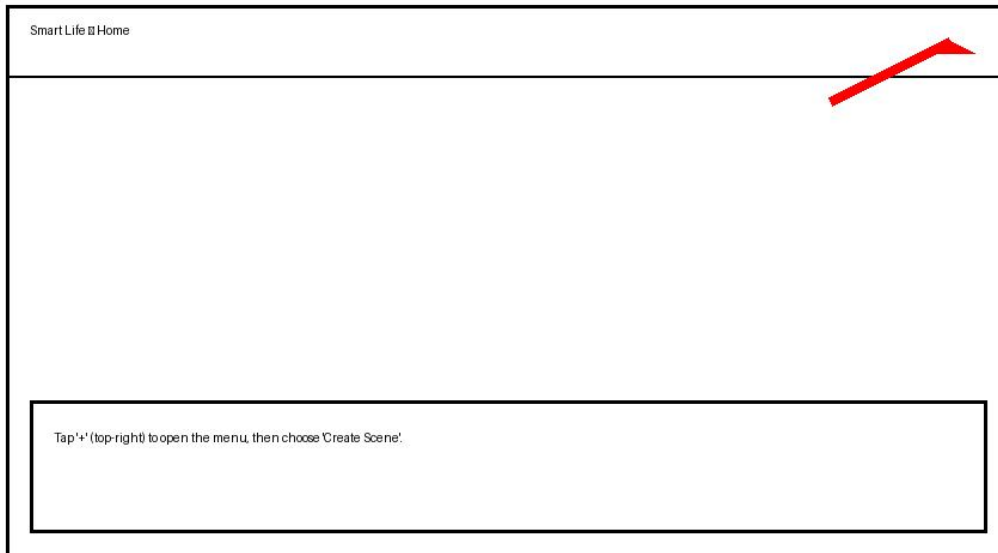


Run & Add to Home

Tap the scene to test, then add it to Favorites/Home if available.

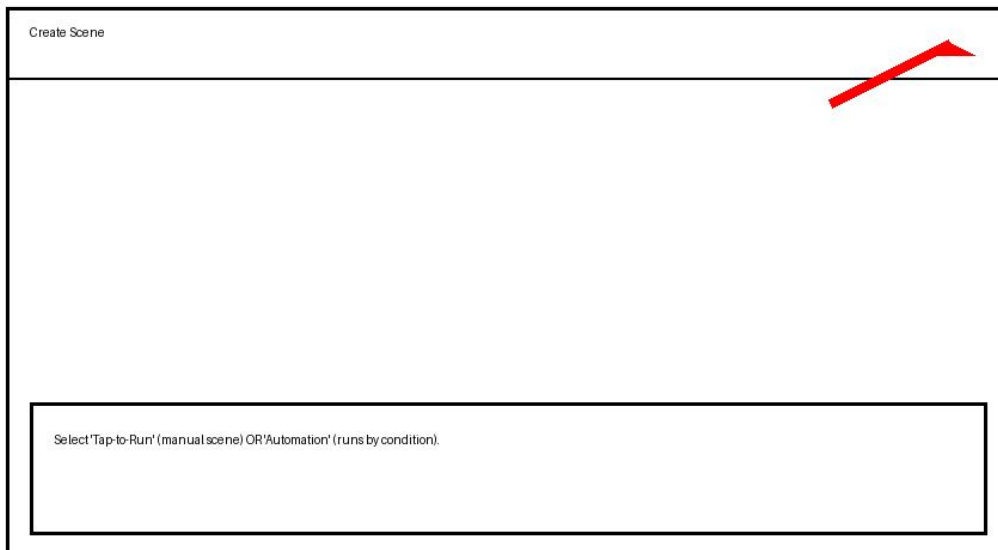
Step 5 – Effective Period (Optional)

Limit when the automation can run (e.g., only at night).



Step 6 – Save

Name the automation and tap Save/Done.



Home User Tips (Avoid Common Problems)

- Keep scene names simple: 'Good Morning', 'Bedtime', 'Away Mode'.
- If an automation does not run, check the trigger conditions and effective period.
- For Zigbee devices, confirm your Zigbee gateway is online.
- If devices respond slowly, check Wi-Fi signal strength and router stability.
